


## Correct knowledge and technology protect patient safety during surgery.

At the Department of Anesthesiology, we manage 1,700 cases annually, including over 400 cases of cardiac surgery. Our motto is "Safety for all times and for all patients". We must assure the safety and well-being of the patient. We aim for a high level of medical services, including the education with a strong sense of professionalism.

The New Tokyo Hospital maintains a 0% incidence rate related to general anesthesia and we are determined to continue our efforts to provide safe surgery 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.



## The new pathological approach using a regional network system

A new system has been developed where the pathological services are being offered through regional network system to our group hospitals. We aim to construct and present "pathological information" to patients and medical staffs in a way that is easy to understand. We have recently developed a real time electronic distribution system for pathological diagnosis information (system name: PathoPACS) presenting both macro- and micro- images of the lesion as well as a text-based report. We believe it is important for better medical services we provide to develop a new interface that connects medical staff and patients using our "pathological information" as an effective tool. PathoPACS was first installed at New Tokyo Hospital in November 2009, and is now being expanded to group hospitals. With this tool, we expect pathology to become more widely recognized and familiar to both patients and medical staff.
